Mangalacharanam By Kavita Shah, Mumbai

In Samskytam literature, whether it's the prose, poetry, drama or any work, the author begins with a मङ्गलाचरणम (mangalācaraṇam). This may be a composition praying to and invoking the grace of the deity (नमस्कार: Namaskārah) or in the form of blessings from the Guru (आशीर्वाद: - āśirvādaḥ) and sometimes also pointing out the of the work (विषयवस्त निर्देशक: subject matter vişayavastunirdeśakah). In this मङ्गलाचरणम् (mangalācaranam), प्रथमेश (Prathameśa) is invoked to remove all the obstacles.



आलम्बे जगदालम्बे हेरम्बचरणाम्बुजे।

शुष्यन्ति यद्रजःस्पर्शात्सधः प्रत्यूहवार्धयः।।

ālambe jagadālambe

herambacranāmbhuje |

śusyanti yadrajah

sparśātsadhaḥ pratyūhavārdhayaḥ ||
